<sup>3</sup> Kia tau ki a koutou te aroha noa, te mahi tohu, me te rangimārie, he mea nā te Atua Matua, nā te Ariki hoki, nā Īhu Karaiti, nā te Tama a te Matua, i runga anō i te pono, i te aroha.

<sup>4</sup> Hari pū ahau nōku i kite i ētahi o āu tamariki e haere ana i runga i te pono, e whakarite ana i te ture kua hōmai ki a tātou e te Matua.

<sup>5</sup> Nā, tēnei anō tāku kupu ki a koe, e tai, ehara i te ture hou tāku e tuhituhi atu nei ki a koe, engari, ko tērā i a tātou nō te tīmatanga, kia aroha tātou tētahi ki tētahi.

<sup>6</sup> Ko te aroha hoki tēnei, kia haere tātou i runga i āna ture. Ko te ture anō tēnei, kia rite ki tā koutou i rongō ai i te tīmatanga, hei runga i tērā he haere-nga mō koutou.

<sup>7</sup> He tokomaha hoki te hunga whakapōhēhē kua tae mai ki te ao, kāhore nei i whakaae i haere mai a Īhu Karaiti i te kikokiko. Ko te kaiwhakapōhēhē tēnei, ko te anataraiti.

<sup>8</sup> Kia whai whakaaro ki a koutou anō, kei mau-mauria ā tātou mahi, engari, kia tino nui te utu e riro i a tātou.

<sup>9</sup> Ko te tangata e poka kē ana, kāhore nei e mau ki te ako a te Karaiti, kāhore te Atua i a ia. Ko te tangata e mau ana ki te ako a te Karaiti, kei tēnei te Matua me te Tama.

<sup>10</sup> Ki te tae atu tētahi ki a koutou, ki te kore tēnei ako e kawea e ia, kua ia e puritia ki te whare, kua anō hoki e oha ki a ia;

<sup>11</sup> ki te oha hoki tētahi ki a ia, ka uru ia ki āna mahi kino.
